- It is situated in the Big Five, malaria free **Madikwe Game Reserve**, South Africa, offering the

- **Madikwe Summer:** September to April, daytime temperatures of approximately 31°C (88°F) with higher chance of rainfall.
- **Madikwe Winter:** May to August, daytime temperatures of approximately 22°C(72°F) and evening temperatures dropping to as low as 2°C(35°F)
- Molori Safari comprises of **five luxury suites**, a main lodge area with four dining areas, a living room and bar opening out onto an outdoor heated Jacuzzi and infinity pool
- The three **Premier Suites** include : Lesedi, Ngwedi & Sephiri Family Suite
- The two **Presidential Suites** include: Metsi, Molelo Family Suite

- **Private Game Drive vehicles** are available at an additional cost for families travelling with children younger than 6 years and for those wanting a more tailor-made safari experience
